Mamma Mia! The Musical

It is extremely important that each member of the cast understands the commitment and furthermore agrees to fulfill the requirements needed to make this show a success. For the purpose of this contract the "director" shall mean Ms. Collins/Ms. Evans

1. Cast members must attend all rehearsals and work calls as needed. Cast members should not be late to rehearsals/calls or ask to leave early. Appointments should be scheduled around the rehearsal period. Any student missing more than one rehearsal/call without approval will be automatically removed from the show. If cast members must miss a rehearsal, a WRITTEN note from a parent or guardian is required to be turned in prior to the absence.
2. Cast members must remain available if extra rehearsals are needed. It is understood that in extreme cases extra rehearsals may be called with only 24 hours notice. Students will be expected to attend these rehearsals.
3. Cast members must have all lines assigned to them memorized word for word by their assigned deadlines. Crew members must also meet required deadlines.
4. Cast members must give 100% during all rehearsals, calls, and performances. **Positive interaction is expected, to include the use of social media. Negative use of social media from cast members is not permitted and will result in immediate removal from the show.**
5. Cast members must have a good working relationship with the director and other cast members and be willing to give and take constructive criticism.
6. Cast members must attempt to sell tickets to the three performances and favorably advertise the production in every way possible.
7. Cast members must agree to help with all aspects of the show when asked by the director.
8. Cast members may be asked to alter their hairstyle to better fit the time period and requirements of the production.
9. Cell phone use will be very limited during rehearsals. All cast members are expected to follow the director's rules.
10. All cast members must have a minimum 2.0 gpa in order to participate in the musical. Grades will be checked at interims, and any member without the required 2.0 will be removed from the show.
11. All district "Student Activity Participation Rules" must also be adhered to.

I have read this contract and promise to fulfill my obligations to the production of Mamma Mia a as outlined above in the requirements. I also understand that if the directors think at any time I am not fulfilling my obligations, they will have a conference with me that could result in my removal from the show. If this does happen I understand that her decision will be final.
